Please complete the STUDENT NOMINATION FORM. In addition, nominations **must** be supported by a written statement (narrative, one page maximum) based on the following criteria:

- Involvement/Leadership in activities promoting global education and international understanding in K-12 classrooms and/or other community organizations.
 - **Activities and organizations may include:**
 - School
 - Classroom teaching, special events, committees
 - 4-H Youth Programs with international focus
 - United Nations and/or other international organizations
 - Model United Nations
 - World Friendship Day
 - International education and/or cultural exchange programs
 - International travel and/or Study Abroad programs
 - Foreign language programs
 - Service Club International projects
 - **Individual Initiatives, including but not limited to:**
 - Special projects which promote international understanding
 - Research with cross-cultural or international focus
 - Family activities and travel which increase cross-cultural understanding
 - Hobbies with global focus
- Recommendations from principals, community leaders, officials, service organizations, educators, etc. are strongly encouraged.
- Any additional information or documentation that will enhance your nominee's selection.
- The GL-UNA student award comes with a small cash prize of \$500.

NOTE: Awards will be based on individual initiative and achievement, rather than on academic standing or test scores.

Nominations must be received no later than Saturday, March 19, 2022.
